Brookland Planning Commission Meeting June 26, 2017

Old Business:

 Brett Baugh – Mini Storage Units: Co-Chair Tim Hudson asked Civil Engineering Rep. Jason MacDonald about the surfacing on this project based on the motion from Jerry Blair that the commission would accept whatever the other partial surface was to be as long as it was approved by Mr. MacDonald. Jason stated that Mr. Baugh had decided to pave the entire surface.

New Business:

 Christina Ballard-resignation as P/C chair-moving out of city. Chairperson needs to be assigned: Co-Chair Tim Hudson read the resignation letter of Christina. He stated that the commission needed to appoint a new chairperson. Jerry Blair asked Mayor Jones about a sixth member that was to be added to the commission. The Mayor stated that there would be one added. Mr. Blair made a motion to table the issue until the 6th person was added. The motion was seconded by Steve Phillips. Being no more discussion, the motion was put to a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

2) Ralph Crain- Lot split at N. Oak Street:

3) Brookland Hills - Phase III Preliminary Layout - George Hammon w/Civilogic Enginnering: George Hammon presented the final layout to the commission for approved. Mr. Frederick asked if the homes were to be the same size as the ones that were built before. Mr. Phillips assure that the new homes would be at least the same size or more.
