#### Ordinance 2018-14

## AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT TO PORTIONS OF EASON STREET

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, for the safety of motorist and pedestrians and for the public benefit and good within the city to set maximum motorized traveling speeds on certain city streets; and

WHEREAS, portions of Eason Street have recently been paved and widened; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** it is hereby ordained that:

1. The maximum speeds allowable to operate a motor vehicle on the streets noted hereafter shall be as indicated:

Eason Street

#### Maximum speed 35 mph

# NOTE: the 35 miles per hour speed limit starts at Maple Slough Ditch Concrete Bridge running South to Three Notch Road.

2. **Emergency Clause,** It being necessary to have a set maximum speed to operate motorized vehicles safely and the well-being of the citizenry of the City of Brookland are of paramount importance to the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, and any injury or damage to any person or property within the city are hereby to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare and well-being of the community may be sustained it is hereby declared that an emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
