ORDINANCE NO. 2026-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2023-06 TO SET SPEED LIMITS FOR DIXIE ROAD IN THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-55-102 shall have the power to make and publish ordinances, not inconsistent with the laws of this state, which, as to them, shall seem necessary to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the morals, order, comfort, and convenience of such inhabitants thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §14-301-101(1) shall have the care, supervision, and control of all the public highways, bridges, streets, alley, public squares, and commons within the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland, Arkansas previously passed Ordinance No. 2023-06 setting speed limits for city streets in the City of Brookland, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, that there have been problems within the city regarding certain streets/roads so that limits on the speeds traveled on said road traveled on said streets/roads by motor vehicles is necessary for the public and school children's benefit and safety, and it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 2023-06 to add speed limits for Dixie Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 2023-06 shall be amended to include the following as set out there in word for word:

r. Dixie Road (from US49B to railroad tracks)	maximum speed 35 mph
Dixie Road (in school zones when children are present)	maximum speed 20 mph

2. Emergency Clause. It being necessary that the health, welfare, safety and well being of the citizenry and children of the City of Brookland are paramount importance to the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas, and injury or damage to any person or property within the city are hereby declared to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare, safety and well being of the community may be sustained it is hereby declared that emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
