Ordinance No-1970-1

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF TOWN TREASURER FOR THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS.

BE It Ordaned by the Town Council of Brookland Arkansas;

Sec. 1, The town council shall select a person to serve as Treasurer of the Town of Brookland, Arkansas.

Sect. 2, The treasurer shall have custody of the funds of the town, write and sign checks on the town funds, and keep a set of books showing the income and expenditures.

Sec, 3, It shall also be the duty of the treasurer to deposit all town moneys in the bank having the town funds within thirty days of the time that he recieves them. He shall meet with the town council at all meetings whenever possible and be ready to inform the council of the financial condition of the town whenever requested to do so by the mayor ar any member of the council. Under reasonable circumstances, no elector of the town shall be denied this information.

Sec. 4, The bond required by the State shall be paid for by the town. The Town council shall fix the salary of the treasurer but no salary shall be fixed or paid under this ordinance before January 1, 1972. The tenure of office of the treasurer is subject to the will of the town council. Election to the Office of Recorder shall not make a person inelegible to serve as treasurer.
