ORDINANCE NO. 1989-1

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of Brookland Arkansas, that there has been problems within the town with regard to certain streets so that limits on the speeds traveled on said streets by motor vehicles is necessary for the public benefit and good; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that an ordinance be established to set such speed limits;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

1. The maximum speeds allowable on the streets noted hereafter shall be as indicated:

Highway 49 to Bernis Street 20 mph permanent

- 2. Any person violating the above ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than $\frac{25.00}{}$, nor more than $\frac{100.00}{}$.
- 3. Emergency Clause. It being necessary that the health, welfare and wellbeing of the citizenry of the Town of Brookland are of paramount importance to the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas, and any injury or damage to any person or property within the town are hereby declared to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare and wellbeing of the community may be sustained it is hereby declared that an emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
