ORDINANCE NO. 1990-1

Whereas, it is determined that in light of Ordinance 1988-1, water billings are not being paid as promptly as desired; and

Whereas, it is deemed necessary that certain action be taken to amend the existing ordinances as amended concerning water billings in an attempt to rectify the problem;

Now therefore, it is hereby ordained that:

1. Paragraph 3 of Ordinance 1988-1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Once any water service shall be cut off within a calendar year to any user due to his/her bill being in default, the water service will only be turned on after payment of any bills outstanding and payment of a \$10.00 service charge if this is the first cut-off of service due to such user being in default. In the event that this is a second cut-off for the user being in default, within said calendar year, then the water service will only be turned on after payment of any bills outstanding and payment of a \$20.00 service charge. In the further event that the water service shall have been cut off for three or more times, within a calendar year due to a water user being in default, then the water service will only be reconnected or turned on after payment of any bills outstanding and payment of a \$40.00 service charge."

- 2. Any existing part of any ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed and Paragraph 3 of Ordinance 1988-1 is hereby replaced by the wording set out in Paragraph 1 of this Ordinance.
- 3. Emergency Clause. It is necessary that the finances and property of the Town of Brookland are of extreme importance and any loss thereof is declared to constitute an emergency in order that the peace, welfare and well-being of the community shall be sustained. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage.
