ORDINANCE NO. 1996-3

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Town Council of Brookland Arkansas, that there has been problems within the town with regard to certain streets so that limits of direction of travel on said streets by motor vehicles is necessary for the public benefit and good; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary that an ordinance be established to set such direction and times;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained that:

- 1. Bernis Street from School Street to Smith Street shall be a one-way street traveling from North to South during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. during the days the Brookland Public Schools are in session.
- 2. Any person violating the above ordinance shall be fined the sum of not less than \$10.00, nor more than \$100.00.
- 3. Emergency Clause. It being necessary that the health welfare and wellbeing of the citizenry of the Town of Brookland are of paramount importance to the Town of Council of Brookland, Arkansas, and any injury or damage to any person or property within the town are hereby declared to constitute an emergency so that in order that the peace, welfare and wellbeing of the community my be sustained it is hereby declared that an emergency exists with regard to this ordinance and the ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage
