## ordinance no.<u>/996-6</u>

WHEREAS, the City has begun operation of certain park areas within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that future parks may be operated within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, it has become evident that there is a necessity for certain rules and regulations for the orderly operation and use of the park system;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained that:

- 1. The park shall be open for use by the public from 7:00 a m. until 10:00 p. m. unless otherwise provided by resolution of the Town Council.
- No alcoholic beverages shall be present or consumed on City Park facilities and property.
- 3. No fireworks shall be ignited or activated on the City Park facilities and property.
- 4. No firearms shall be allowed upon the City Park facilities and property except for those possessed duly authorized officers of the law in the course of their police work.
- 5. The City Park facilities or grounds shall not be used by anyone less than seven years of age without being accompanied by an adult.
- 6. No littering shall occur or be allowed upon the City Park facilities or grounds.
- 7. The pavilion facilities on the City Park grounds may be reserved and used by the payment of \$20.00 to the Town which shall be held as a cleaning deposit and returned if the facilities are returned in a clean, undamaged and orderly condition, otherwise to be retained. The Town Council may adjust said cleaning deposit amount by resolution as necessities may require.
- 8. The Town shall not be responsible for accidents in or around the park facilities or property, and any individuals on the park facilities shall be considered to have assumed the risk of the use of such facilities.

## **PENALTY**

9. Any person violating any portion of this ordinance shall be considered guilty of a violation and shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each separate violation.

## EMERGENCY CLAUSE

10. It is hereby determined by the Town Council of Brookland, Arkansas, that an emergency exists with respect to the orderly and proper operation, maintenance and care of the park facilities and property within the Town of Brookland, Arkansas, due to the fact that there have been substantial abuses with regard to the use and operation of such park facilities and property. Therefore, an emergency is considered to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
