

Ordinance# 2002-16

WHEREAS, The City of Brookland has suffered damages to its drainage facilities and roads due to the riding of all terrain vehicles upon its streets and through and over its ditches and drainage facilities and rights of way; and

WHEREAS, appropriate action is required to preserve the peace, safety and integrity of the populace and public property and rights of way; now, therefore

It is hereby Ordained as follows:

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any all terrain vehicle, 4-wheeler, 3-wheeler or similar vehicle to be ridden or operated upon the streets, roads, ditches or drainage areas, facilities or rights of way owned or maintained by the City of Brookland.
- 2. Any person found violating paragraph (1) of this ordinance shall be fined a sum of no less than \$10 and no more than \$100 for each such violation.
- 3. **Emergency Clause:** It is hereby found and determined that the preservation of city property and the peace, safety and integrity of the populace is of the utmost importance, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist so that this ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.
