ORDINANCE NO. 2004-1

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING FIVE OF THE MOST PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF BROOKLAND FOR PURPOSES OF ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED SECTION 14-55-206; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated § 14-55-206 (the "Act") provides that all ordinances of a general or permanent nature shall be published in some newspaper in a municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Act also provides that, in municipalities in which no newspaper is published, written or printed notice of the five most public places designated by ordinance of the governing body of a municipality shall be deemed a sufficient publication of any ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas (the "City") wishes to designate five of the most public places in the City for purposes of the Act;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City that:

SECTION 1. The following places are hereby designated as five of the most public places in the City for purposes of the Act:

1. Brookland City Hall;
2. Brookland Post Office;
3. Southern Bank of Commerce;
4. Glenda's Beauty Service; and
5. Bearcuts.

SECTION 2. The City hereby ascertains and declares that uncertainty exists with respect to the public places at which ordinances of the City which affect the public welfare may be posted for purposes of the Act. It is, therefore, declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
