ORDINANCE NO. 2004-14

(Amending Ordinance 2004-9)

WHEREAS, there has been a street right of way dedicated to the City of Brookland, by previous action regarding certain real property located in Brookland, Arkansas; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brookland has no desire to accept said street and desires to abandon said dedication and easement; and

WHEREAS, the said dedication was described on the attached plat of survey dated November 3, 2004 prepared for Brian Allred by Dale Adamson, registered professional land surveyor; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2004-9 was enacted, but request has been made to clarify said decision and an amendment should be made to said Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of Brookland, Arkansas does hereby ordain as follows:


- That the street dedicated as shown upon the attached plats of survey hereinbefore noted which relates to property in Martin's First Replat of a part of Dickson's Addition to Brookland, Arkansas is not needed for any streets or right of way by the City of Brookland.
- That the City of Brookland hereby abandons all right, claim or interest in or to said dedicated and unused street noted on the plat attached and prepared by Adamson Land Surveying.
- 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That the City of Brookland, Arkansas determines that there is an immediate need for the abandonment of the aforesaid property so that construction can promptly begin on said property, and it constitutes an emergency with regard to the orderly and prompt improvements of the property in question and surrounding property given the time of year and circumstances surrounding same. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force in and after its passage.
