

AN ORDINANCE TO RESTRICT THE SHOOTING OF FIREWORKS WITHIN IN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS

ORDINANCE NO. 2006-1

WHEREAS, in many areas in the City of Brookland, Arkansas, fireworks have been discharged for extended periods of time in and around certain holidays and cause a nuisance; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Brookland, Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKLAND, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to discharge fireworks within the corporate city limits, except for the provisions of Section 2.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to discharge fireworks within the corporate city limits except for the following dates and times:

- (1) Fireworks may be discharged between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on June 29, June 30, July 1, July 2, July 3, July 5, December 30 and January 1.
- (2) Fireworks may be discharged between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and will be extended until 12:30 a.m. (of the following day) on July 4 and December 31.

Section 3. Any person in violation of the provisions of this ordinance, shall for each such offense, be punished by a fine of not less than \$25.00 and no more than \$100.00.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage.
