

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 AND SECTION 5 AND DELETING SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1980-2 CHANGING THE PROCEDURE BY WHICH UTITILITIES ARE PAID ON A CITY OWNED BUILDING HOUSING THE BROOKLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT EQUIPMENT.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Brookland, Craighead County, Arkansas, that:

Section 1. Article 4 of Ordinance No. 1980-2 (as previously amended) is amended to read as follows:

"Article 4: The City of Brookland, Arkansas hereby agrees to provide housing for the necessary equipment owned or leased by the Brookland Fire Protection District."

Section 2. Article 5 of Ordinance No. 1980-2 (as previously amended) is amended to read as follows:

"Article 5: The Brookland Fire Protection District will be responsible for all electric, gas, sewer and water through the ¾" meter at the housing provided by the City of Brookland, Arkansas, provided the City of Brookland shall supply water through the 2" meter to the Brookland Fire Protection District up to 50,000 gallons per month for fire protection. Any water used in excess of 50,000 gallons per month will be billed to the Brookland Fire Protection District after review by the Mayor and City Council. Water billed in excess of 50,000 gallons per month usage may be waived, upon City Council approval."

Section 3. Article 6 of Ordinance No. 1980-2 is hereby deleted and the remainder of Ordinance No. 1980-2 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Emergency Clause

In an effort to better serve the residents of the City of Brookland, Arkansas and surrounding residents, a new building was constructed to house the Brookland Fire Protection District equipment. This amendment to Ordinance No. 1980-2 will allow the fire district to respond to emergency calls in a safe and timely manner. It is hereby found that an emergency is

declared to exist and this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Brookland, Arkansas and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
