

AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING JIMMY ANDREWS TO SERVE ON THE BROOKLAND PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Brookland City Council is given the authority in accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated §14-56-404 AND Arkansas Code Annotated §14-56-405 to appoint a person and their term to the planning commission created by this legislative body;

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated §14-56-404 states the planning commission may be created with not less than five (5) members, of whom at least two-thirds (2/3) shall not hold any other municipal office or appointment;

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code Annotated §14-42-107(b)(1) states no alderman, council member, official, or municipal employee shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in the profits of any contract for furnishing supplies, equipment, or services to the municipality unless the governing body of the city has enacted an ordinance specifically permitting aldermen, council members, officials, or municipal employees to conduct business with the city and prescribing the extent of this authority;

WHEREAS, the Brookland City Council finds it necessary to enact an ordinance to appoint Jimmy Andrews to serve on the Brookland Planning Commission;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Brookland does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Jimmy Andrews is hereby appointed to the Brookland City Planning Commission for a term of <u>three</u> years.

SECTION 2. Jimmy Andrews shall have the power and authority just as all other members of the Brookland City Planning Commission as established by its own rules, procedures and in accordance with Arkansas law.

SECTION 3. It is hereby specifically determined that Jimmy Andrews, as a city employee, is allowed to serve on the Brookland City Planning Commission and is not in violation of Arkansas Code Annotated §14-42-107.

READING REQUIRMENT. In accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated Section §14-55-202, all ordinances of a general or permanent nature shall be fully and distinctly read on three (3) different days unless two-thirds (2/3) of the members composing the municipal council shall dispense with the rule. It is hereby found and declared by the City Council of the City of Brookland, Arkansas, that two-thirds (2/3) of the members composing the municipal council dispose of the three readings.
