The facts for Distracted Driving are this:

National Distracted Driving Stats

- 3,275 people were killed in distracted driving crashes in 2023.
- An estimated 324,819 people were injured in traffic crashes involving distracted drivers in 2023.
- 8% of fatal crashes, an estimated 13% of injury crashes, and an estimated 13% of all police-reported traffic crashes were reported as distraction-affected in 2023.
- 7% of drivers 15 to 20 years old involved in fatal crashes were reported as distracted. This
 age group has the largest proportion of drivers who were distracted at the time of the fatal
 crashes.
- 611 nonoccupants (pedestrians, pedalcyclists, and others) were killed in distractionaffected traffic crashes in 2023.
